GENERAL INFORMATION

1. INTRODUCTION

- 1.1 Council is requesting tenders from suitable suppliers for the supply and delivery of one (1) new grader with a 135kw engine and 14ft moldboard.
- 1.2 This machine will be used by various Council departments primarily on rural work site locations.
- 1.3 This machine is to be used for maintenance & construction grading extensively through the Bulloo Shire in extremely hard & hot conditions.
- 1.4 This machine will be required to travel on regional rural roads (sealed & unsealed) and must be registered to do so.
- 1.5 All prices submitted shall be GST inclusive and all requirements will be shown as Standard or Non-Standard.
- 1.6 An individual price (GST Inclusive) must be provided for all Non-Standard items.
- 1.7 Brochures of plant providing engine capacity and tray sizes are to be provided.
- 1.8 Lowest or any tender not necessarily accepted.

2. SUBMISSION REQUIREMENT

- 2.1 Tenders must be clearly labelled with the tender number '**T2020-2021-102**' and addressed to:

- 2.2 Tenders must be submitted via one of the following methods:
 - a) Email at Tender@bulloo.qld.gov.au ONLY; or
 - b) Post; or
 - c) Over the counter at Bulloo Shire Council's Administration Centre (office hours 8.30am to 4.00pm, Monday - Friday).
- 2.3 All tenders will be placed in the Tender Box located at Council's Administration Centre.
- 2.4 Any tender received after the closing date will not be accepted.
- 2.5 Council reserves the right to consider a tender which is not received at the electronic mail address by the closing time if, in Council's opinion, no commercial advantage has been gained by the tender being delivered to the electronic mail address late.
- 2.6 All tenders submitted shall take into account that:
 - a) Technical Specifications are to be read in conjunction with the Pricing Schedule and Warranty and Parts.

- b) It is **mandatory** to complete in full each schedule/section in accordance with the equipment being tendered.
 - c) Quote schedules must be completed and supplemented with requested information.
 - d) Complete copies of schedules are required if **multiple items** are tendered.
- 2.7 The information provided within the Pricing Schedule and Warranty and Parts will take precedence over attached letters and documentation.
- 2.8 Failure to fully complete the required responses in the Pricing Schedule and Warranty and Parts may deem your submission non-conforming or at least a score of "0" for the relating evaluation criteria.
- 2.9 Tenderers are not to contact Council staff regarding this tender without the permission of the Contact Officer. Failure to comply with this direction may deem that particular submission void and may not be evaluated further.

3. DEMONSTRATION ASSESSMENT

- 3.1 To assist with the assessment and evaluation process, demonstration of the model/s tendered may be required from selected tenderers. If required, those selected tenderers will be invited via email to demonstrate their machine at a date and place nominated in the invitation.
- 3.2 If tendered model is not available for demonstration, referees (current owners of same model) may be supplied, provided Council may view their machine.
- 3.3 Inability to demonstrate plant may result in failure to comply or at least a score of "0" for the relating evaluation criteria. If the plant has been assessed within the previous 6 months, or the Council already operates the make and model tendered, further assessment may not be required unless a significant upgrade has been introduced.

4. REGISTRATION

- 4.1 Plant is to be registered prior to delivery.
- 4.2 Registration is to be for the common due date **10th of July. Customer No 064 353 849. CTP insurance is to be with Suncorp Insurance Limited.**
- 4.3 Registration will be authorised at time of purchase and must be invoiced separately.
- 4.4 Registration plates are to be fitted in a visible and road legal position or a police exemption permit is to be provided on delivery.

5. DELIVERY AND ACCEPTANCE

- 5.1 Plant is to be delivered FIS to Council's Works Depot, Thargomindah.
- 5.2 Should your tender be successful, the plant item will be assessed, accepted and commissioned in conjunction with the supplier and a representative of Bulloo Shire Council and/or nominated officer.

- 5.3 Due to certification requirements, Council will not accept plant that is three months past the build date stated on the compliance plate unless approval has been given.
- 5.4 Training is to be provided as required by Council prior to or on delivery for both operators and maintenance personnel. This is to be documented.
- 5.5 Plant item must meet State and Federal Transport Regulations, Australian Standards and Design Rules, Workplace Health and Safety Regulations.
- 5.6 All signage is to meet current MUTCD requirements.
- 5.7 Any repairs undertaken during the warranty period shall not incur charges for overtime, accommodation, travel, parts or labour.
- 5.8 Machine shall meet all WH&S and ADR requirements for operator access and accommodation.
- 5.9 It is the responsibility of the successful tenderer to ensure the delivery time is met. If the delivery time is not met, and timely communication resulting in a new delivery time that is acceptable, the purchase order may be cancelled.
- 5.10 Plant is to be functionally tested prior to delivery to Council.
