HORSE HOLDING PADDOCK

- The fenced area adjacent to the race course reserve is deemed to be paddock for the short term holding of horses.
- The maximum number of horses allowable in the Horse Holding Paddock at any one time will be at the discretion of the RLO.
- Transfer of horses between the Thargomindah town common and the horse holding paddock will be managed by the RLO and carried out on application by the owner of horses being agisted on the common.
- Horses may remain in the Horse Holding Paddock for a maximum period of 1 month.
- The total number allowed to de pasture in the Horse Holding Paddock per residence is 4 (including foals), however the number permitted per residence may be reduced depending upon number of residences wishing to place horses in the paddock.
- All horses de pastured in the Horse Holding Paddock must be registered with the Bulloo Shire Council.
- The gates to the Horse Holding Paddock are to be locked at all times.
- To enable applicants to enter the paddock and tend their horse/s, at the time the application form is submitted a key to the Horse Holding Paddock will be issued to the applicant, who will return the key to the Bulloo Shire Council office when the horse/s are removed from the paddock. These keys will be entered in Council's Key Register.
- If the Applicant loses the key to the Horse Holding Paddock that they have been issued, the lock and all keys to the Horse Holding Paddock are to be replaced at the expense of the Applicant
- No Stallions are allowed to be de pastured in the Horse Holding Paddock
- The Applicant is to remove horse/s from the Horse Holding Paddock if and when directed by an authorised person.

FEES

- Council will set agistment fees as part of its annual budget process.
- Any stock on the common which do not have fees paid up to date or are not correctly registered with Council
 will be deemed to be straying stock and impounded in accordance with Council's Local Law.
